MEL BROOKS (Book, Composer & Lyricist) Director, producer, writer and actor, Mel Brooks is the recipient of three 2001 Tony® Awards (Best Score, Best Book of a Musical, Best Musical) and two **Grammy® Awards (Best Musical** Show Album and Best Long-Form Music Video) for The Producers. Mr. Brooks began his distinguished career during television's Golden Age as a writer for Sid Caesar on "Your Show of Shows" in 1951. In 1955 and in 1957. Brooks received Emmy® Award nominations (with others) for Best Comedy Writing for "Caesar's Hour." and in 1956 he was nominated (with others) for Best Writing for a Variety or Situation Comedy. In 1952. Brooks wrote sketches for Leonard Sillman's Broadway

smash-hit revue. New Faces of 1952, and in 1957, together with Joe Darion, he wrote the book for the Broadway musical *Shinbone* Alley, which starred Eartha Kitt. In 1962, he wrote the book for the Broadway musical All American, starring Ray Bolger. In the '60s, Brooks teamed up with Carl Reiner to write and perform The 2000 Year Old Man albums. which became immediate bestsellers. In 1960 and 1961. Brooks and Reiner received Grammv® Award nominations for Best Spoken-Word Comedy for 2000 Years and for Best Comedy Performance for 2000 and One Years. respectively. In 1997, Brooks and Reiner teamed up again for The 2000 Year Old Man in the Year 2000. Both a book and CD were released, the CD winning a Grammy® Award in 1998 for the Best Spoken-Word Album, Comedy. Brooks wrote and narrated The Critic, a short satire on avantgarde art films, which received the Academy Award for Best Animated Short Subject in 1964. In 1965, he teamed up with Buck Henry and created "Get Smart," the long-running television show starring Don Adams as Agent 86. Brooks, along with others, received an Emmy® Award for Outstanding Writing Achievement in Comedy-Variety in 1967 for "The Sid Caesar, Imogene Coca, Carl Reiner, Howard Morris Special," In 1968, he wrote and directed his first feature film. The Producers. starring Zero Mostel and Gene Wilder, which earned him an **Academy Award for Best Original** Screenplay Written Directly for the Screen. He then went on to create a remarkable string of hit comedies: 1970. wrote. directed and acted in The Twelve Chairs: 1974, co-wrote, directed and acted in Blazing Saddles and was nominated, along with John Morris, for Best Title Song, "Blazing Saddles";

THEATRE BY THE SEA, which is on the National Register of Historic Places, has had many incarnations over the years. The Tyler family purchased the property in the early '20s. After Alice Tyler was left a widow with three young children, she ran the property as a summer camp for girls. When the depression hit, she decided to create jobs and provide a future for her children by turning the barn into a theatre. The 300-seat theatre opened on August 7, 1933 with a production called *Strictly* Dynamite. That initial season lasted four weeks and featured four different plays, one of which was taken to New York. In 1938, a Yale Cooperative took over. Then, on September 2, a hurricane hit.

The back wall of the theatre caved in and the stage roof was blown off. During the repairs, the theater was expanded to include a balcony. The newly enlarged theatre operated through 1941 and then went dark during the war. In 1946, the theatre's most glamorous and star-filled period began. The theatre became what is referred to as a "star-system" house opening with a show called Dream Girl which starred Judy Holliday. Other headliners who were brought in included Tallulah Bankhead, Mae West, Groucho Marx, and Marlon Brando. Following the 1958 season, the property was sold to the Bontecou family, who leased it sporadically for several years, and by 1966 there were plans to tear down the theatre. Upon hearing that the theatre was to be destroyed, Tommy Brent, who had previously worked as a publicist for the theatre, returned and saved the theater from demolition. His first show opened on

June 23, 1967 and he ran the theatre successfully for 22 years. In 1988. FourOuest Entertainment. which consisted of Laura Harris. (who had previously worked at the theatre for 11 summers). Renny Serre and Richard Ericson, came on board. Following extensive renovations, FourQuest reopened the theater in the spring of 1989 and continued producing high quality summer theater in Matunuck until the fall of 2003. The theatre went dark once again until 2007, when entrepreneur Bill Hanney purchased the property and, with producing partners, successfully mounted a production of A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum. just six weeks later, reopening the historic theatre on August 8, 2007. 


