




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From the desk of BILL HANNEY Owner and Producer

Thank you so much for joining us for Theatre By The Sea's 90^{th} Anniversary! We're so happy you are here to celebrate the longevity of this historic barn theatre!

Traditionally the 90th Anniversary is known as the stone or granite anniversary, which signifies a relationship that is solid and long-lasting. That is certainly true of this very special place, which was envisioned by Alice Tyler in 1933, to not only entertain but to help create jobs during the Great Depression.

It began as a 300-seat theatre, (which was later increased to 500 with the addition of a balcony in the late 1930s), and has had numerous visionaries at the helm, including the beloved Tommy Brent, who saved the theatre from demolition in 1967 and ran the theatre until 1988 and Laura Harris, Renny Serre, and Richard Ericson, (known as FourQuest Entertainment), who, after extensive renovations, reopened the theater in 1989 and continued to produce high quality live entertainment for 15 seasons. In 2007, after a few dark years, I was fortunate to have had the opportunity to purchase the property and continue the tradition.

I am very proud of the work we have done here, which not only includes the main stage musicals, children's performances, and the continuation of the Late Night Cabaret, but we also added a Monday Evening Concert Series, which presents a variety of entertainment throughout the summer and we created a children's camp which not only educates, but also gives campers an opportunity to perform on the same stage that hosted Marlon Brando, Carol Channing, Groucho Marx, Tallulah Bankhead, Mae West, Judy Holiday, Shelley Winters, and many others.

I am also proud and truly appreciative of the dedicated staff members who work tirelessly to create magic year after year. From the artistic professionals, including directors and designers, to the small but mighty year-round staff who wear numerous hats, to the seasonal production staff and performers with whom we couldn't be without.

Many people marvel at the fact that not only is Theatre By The Sea still in business, but it is thriving. It's truly the "little theatre that could!" This season is a reflection of the theatre itself – celebrating singers who defied the odds, rose to the top and defined their generations.

Again, thank you for your unwavering patronage! We certainly couldn't do it without you!



DOUGLAS McGRATH (Book) is a filmmaker, playwright and essayist. His films include Emma, Nicholas Nickleby, Company Man and Infamous. He was nominated for an Oscar for the screenplay of Bullets Over Broadway. He has made two documentaries for HBO: His Way, about the legendary music promoter and movie producer Jerry Weintraub, and Becoming Mike Nichols for which he received an Emmy nomination. His book for Beautiful was nominated for the Tony,



Drama Desk and Outer Critics Awards. His other plays include his adaptation of Edith Wharton's *The Age of Innocence* and *Checkers*. His essays have appeared in the New Yorker, Vanity Fair and Air Mail.

GERRY GOFFIN (*Words and Music*). Born in Brooklyn in 1939, Gerry Goffin met Carole King at Queens College, and their musical collaboration began almost immediately. They married in 1959, and that same year wrote their first hit song "Will You Love Me Tomorrow?" (The Shirelles). The duo penned more than 50 Top- 40 hits including "The Locomotion," "Natural Woman" and "Up on the Roof." In 1987, Goffin and King were inducted into the Songwriters Hall of Fame, and the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame in 1990. Goffin has left an indelible mark on American music.

CAROLE KING (Words and Music). Pop music would be very different without the contributions of Carole King, who at age 17 wrote her first #1 hit with Gerry Goffin, "Will You Love Me Tomorrow," for the Shirelles. The dozens of chart hits Goffin and King wrote during this period became legendary, but it was 1971's *Tapestry* that took King to the pinnacle, speaking personally to her contemporaries and providing a spiritual musical backdrop to the decade. More than 400 of her compositions have been recorded by over 1,000 artists, resulting in 100 hit singles and six Grammys.

BARRY MANN (*Words and Music*) has written the melodies of some of the most influential pop songs in musical history. In addition to "You've Lost That Lovin' Feeling," the most-played song of the last century, and the songs heard in *Beautiful*, he composed later standards like "Somewhere Out There" (winner of two Grammys), "Here You Come Again," "Sometimes When We Touch," "Just Once" and "Don't Know Much." Together, he and Cynthia Weil have amassed an incredible 112 pop, country and R&B awards from Broadcast Music Inc. for significant radio air play. He has been inducted into both the Songwriters Hall of Fame and the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame.

CYNTHIA WEIL (Words and Music) is known as the lyricist of classic songs such as "You've Lost That Lovin' Feeling," the most-played song of the 20th century. In addition to the songs heard in *Beautiful*, she set the words to later standards including "Somewhere Out There," "Here You Come Again," "He's So Shy," "Just Once" and "Don't Know Much," to name just a few. Weil has been inducted into the Songwriters Hall of





Fame, the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame, honored with multiple Grammy nominations and two Grammy awards for "Somewhere Out There" as the Motion Picture Song of the Year and Song of the Year.

MICHAEL D. JABLONSKI (Director/Choreographer) is excited to return to TBTS where he appeared in West Side Story and Joseph...Dreamcoat (2000). 



ABOUT THE THEATRE

THEATRE BY THE SEA, which is on the National Register of Historic Places, has had many incarnations over the years. The Tyler family purchased the property in the early '20s. After Alice Tyler was left a widow with three young children, she ran the property as a summer camp for girls. When the depression hit, she decided to create jobs and provide a future for her children by turning the barn into a theatre. The 300-seat theatre opened on August 7, 1933 with a production called Strictly Dynamite. That initial season lasted four weeks and featured four different plays, one of which was taken to New York. In 1938, a Yale Cooperative took over. Then, on September 2, a hurricane hit. The back wall of the theatre caved in and the stage roof was blown off. During the repairs, the theater was expanded to include a balcony. The newly enlarged theatre operated through 1941 and then went dark during the war. In 1946, the theatre's most glamorous and star-filled period began. The theatre became what is referred to as a "star-system" house opening with a show called Dream Girl which starred Judy Holliday. Other headliners who were brought in included Tallulah Bankhead, Mae West, Groucho Marx, and Marlon Brando. Following the 1958 season, the property was sold to the Bontecou family, who leased it sporadically for several years, and by 1966 there were plans to tear down the theatre. Upon hearing that the theatre was to be destroyed, Tommy Brent, who had previously worked as a publicist for the theatre, returned and saved the theater from demolition. His first show opened on June 23, 1967 and he ran the theatre successfully for twenty-two years. In 1988, FourQuest Entertainment, which consisted of Laura Harris, (who had previously worked at the theatre for eleven summers), Renny Serre and Richard Ericson, came on board. Following extensive renovations, FourQuest reopened the theater in the spring of 1989 and continued producing high quality summer theater in Matunuck until the fall of 2003. The theatre went dark once again until 2007, when entrepreneur Bill Hanney purchased the property and, with producing partners, successfully mounted a production of A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum, just six weeks later, reopening the historic theatre on August 8, 2007. Theatre By The Sea continues to annually produce a successful four-musical subscription season along with a children's theatre and concert series.

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
